### Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

A 100% refund of the entry fee will be given for any bitch that comes into season with written notification from a veterinarian provided to the Trial Secretary before the first class of the day.

### Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk through.

## CLASSES OFFERED

### Classes Offered

All levels of Standard STD, JWW, FAST and T2B, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.** The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

**Move-ups, Errors, Confirmation Protocols** Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing (mail or email) by **6 pm, Eastern Daylight time, Wednesday, May 13, 2026.** Requests for move-ups over the phone **will not be accepted.** Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted on the move-up form provided, to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes after completion of the last class of the day.

**DNA Requirement for GSP entries only:** DNA number should be written in the "Variety" field of the entry form for all GSPs competing on Tuesday May 6<sup>th</sup> (the National Specialty Show). GSPs with ILP/PAL numbers do not need to include a DNA number.

## AWARDS, RIBBONS AND PRIZE INFORMATION

### Awards

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the show. Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class except for T2B where first only is awarded.

### High In Trial for German Shorthaired Pointers Only:

**HIT For German Shorthaired Pointers only:** High in Trial ribbons will be awarded on Monday and Tuesday for GSPs only: The German Shorthaired Pointer that earns a QQ from the Regular Excellent or Master Standard and JWW classes and has the highest average yards per second determined by averaging the YPS of the two runs across the Standard and Jumpers classes. If no QQs are earned from the regular classes, then any QQ earned from the Preferred Excellent or Master classes will be considered. If no QQs are earned in either Regular or Preferred, then if a GSP in regular qualifies in Excellent/Master in Regular Standard, it will win. If more than one GSP were to qualify in Standard, the GSP the highest YPS will be used. If none qualify in Regular Standard, then Excellent/Master Preferred Standard will be used. If none in qualify, then Excellent/Master Regular JWW will be used, followed by Excellent/Master Preferred JWW. Progression to Open, then Novice will occur if no qualifiers occur in M/E levels. A GSP HIT Ribbon will be awarded on Each Day of the Event.

### Judy and Bruni Spirit Award

On each day the GSPCA will present a special ribbon award to a person at either set of trials who during that day exhibits the spirit, sportsmanship, and kindness shown by our missed member Judy Shinogle and her GSP Bruni – they were killed by a drunk driver on the way to an agility trial in 2012. We strive to remember their spirit and contributions to the Agility Sport and German Shorthaired Pointer Agility by awarding the most entertaining moment or run – it will be awarded sometime during each trial – all competitors at the trial are eligible including non-GSP competitors – the spirit of inclusion was something Judy would have insisted on! – the GSPCA Event Committee will determine the winners each day

### MACH/PACH Award

Any Dog and Handler Team earning a MACH or PACH (Please notify Trial Chair if you are close) Award: MACH/PACH Rosette and Bar. Three bars will be available – GSPCA will provide a bar or ribbon after the trial if more than three MACH/PACHs occur during the two trials.

## ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all breeds and all-American dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program -- 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breed dogs** listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter these AKC agility trials.

## Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured. A VMO will be available at this trial. If a When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*.

## FIX AND GO ON & FEO INFORMATION

### Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

#### Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights

within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

## Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. As of July 1, 2024, FEO will be allowed in ALL classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

## Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

### Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry will be sent to each exhibitor upon entry; and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. **Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.**

- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial, less all fees, injured or ill dogs less a \$10 processing fee. Bitches in season will receive 100% refund less a \$10 processing fee. No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial. Verification from a vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Family Dog Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions or circumstances beyond our control (global pandemic).
- **DOG ACCESS & EXERCISE AREA:** This is a "self cleaning" show. Owners/ handlers are responsible and **MUST** clean up after their dogs. No exceptions. The Show Committee will police the grounds and any exhibitor not cleaning up after their dogs will be fined \$100.00 for the first offense. Additional offenses will be dealt with by an Event Committee Hearing. Please be respectful at your hotel/ motel and pick up after your dogs at those locations as well.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- **FOOD:** Food and beverages will be available for purchase. A Food Truck and/or Coffee Cart will be onsite daily.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. **INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form.
